

# CONTEMPORARY ARTS CHEESE LIST

1. Appleby's Smoked Cheshire - Crumbly with a fresh tangy flavour, smoked over oak bark, to give rich distinctive flavour
2. Joseph Year Both Round Cheshire - One of the oldest English cheeses dating back to the 12th century. Moist, silky texture with a slightly salty, milky flavour.
3. Ravens Oak Kidderton Goats Cheese  
One of the countries Great Cheese Marques from Burland Nr Nantwich. Started in 1999 in a small dairy this labour of love has grown to national acclaim the cheese is a lovely delicate and aromatic style.
4. Green Thunder Mash Geddar This Mash Dairy has produced some fine cheese and has won gold in the 2006 World Cheese Awards for its efforts. The Green Thunder has garden herbs and garlic running through it.
5. Syrupshire Blue Cheese An orange - hued cheese with veins of greenish-blue, flavours reminiscent of both Stilton and Cheshire. This example is both sharp and creamy, wonderfully rich, enjoy with a dark ale or full on red
