Sauvignon Blanc, Crusan, France 4.40 / 23.95

Fresh and succulent. This little quaffer is beautifully dry and crisp!

Chenin Blanc, Reign of Terroir, South Africa 4.40 / 23.95

Lovely warm fruit aromatics, full and rich on the palate, very easy drinking!

Sauvignon Blanc, San Elias, Chile 5.30 / 28.95

Fresh and zesty, packed with apple and gooseberry notes.

Pinot Grigio, Corte Strada, Italy 4.55 / 24.95

Soft apple aromas with a zesty lemon touch for that true Italian flair.

Marsanne Viognier, Rare Vineyards, France 4.75 / 25.95

Rhone grapes go on holiday to the south of France! Fresh, peachy soft and rounded.

Sauvignon Blanc, Tokomaru Bay, New Zealand 5.85 / 31.95

A real corker! A good squeeze of lemon and bags of tropical fruits.

Chardonnay, San Elias, Central Valley, Chile 5.30 / 28.95

Smooth and well balanced with a touch of honey.

Picpoul De Pinet, Domaine des Lauriers, France 32.95

Bone dry. If you enjoy a crisp Sauvignon, this little number will float your boat.

Piesporter Riesling Trocken, Hain, Mosel, Germany 34.95

Creamy and refreshing with plenty of appley acidity. Not too sweet!

Orange Natural Wine JP, Recas Estate, Romania 29.95

Something different! Citrus and floral notes mixed with dried fruit flavours to give a nutty and spicy finish.

Vinho Verde, Lago, Portugal 29.95

The perfect tickle on the tongue with delicious tropical flavours.

Zonin Lugana DOC, Veneto, Italy 31.95

Delicate and harmoniously balanced fruity and floral notes, with fabulous freshness.

Rioja Blanco, Cueva De Lobos, Spain 34.95

A bright straw colour, with floral nuances and citrus notes on the nose.

Albariño, Rías Baixas, Sand Boy, Spain 35.95

Beautifully refreshing with ripe juicy stone fruit and lush acidity.

Elegant, well rounded and crisp, with a bouquet of ripe apples and pears.

Sancerre, Cuvée Pierre à Feu, France 48.95

Full of citrus, grapefruit and crisp green apple notes. With great texture, classic minerality and herby notes.

Chablis 1er Cru, Beauroy, Michaut Frères, France 61.95

Fresh and vibrant, plenty of fruit with that unmistakable note of flinty "terroir".

Cava Brut, Tanners, Spain 34.95

Finesse in a glass! Creamy and biscuity with a lovely fine mousse.

Champagne, Pierre Mignon, Grand Reserve Brut, France 49.95

Well balanced, fresh, crisp and lively with an elegant creamy mousse and a long finish.

Champagne, Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label Brut, France 64.95

The famous Widow Clicquot. A true feminist. Strong, dependable, free spirited and fun.

Red Wines

Sangiovese Di Romagna, Fico Grande, Italy 4.40 / 23.95

Soft and supple with lovely red fruit characteristics and hints of spice and pepper.

Shiraz, Mountbridge, Australia 5.10 / 27.95

Ripe and juicy. Packed fully of black fruit flavours, with classic notes of pepper on the finish.

Merlot, Santa Rita, Gran Hacienda, Chile 4.75 / 25.95

Bright, plush and very tasty! Lots of juice red fruit and a long, moreish finish.

Pinot Noir, Rare Vineyards, France 4.90 / 26.95

Smooth velvety palate with cherry flavours, warm baking spices and elegant earthiness.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Pato Torrente, Central Valley, Chile 4.90 / 26.95

Full and round, dry with a strong, spicy character. Packed full of cassis and red cherries on the palate.

Malbec, Cinco Fincas, Argentina 5.45 / 29.95

Soft, juicy and packed with brambles and berries, plums and figs. Supple and satisfying.

Rioja, Vivanco Estate, Crianza, Spain 6.40 / 34.95

Delicious Rioja. Deep colour, ripe plum and cherry fruit aromas with a smoky dimension.

Primitivo, Rocca Estate, Puglia, Italy 31.95

Deliciously velvety, with ripe cherry and plum notes.

Montepulciano D'Abruzzo, Ventiterre, Italy 5.30 / 28.95

Smooth and full bodied, with wild berry notes.

Ventoux, Le Vin de Léonard, Rhône Valley, France 32.94

Ripe strawberry fruit, a touch of spice, soft supple tannins and a peppery finish.

Fleurie, Château De Fleurie Loron, France 49.95

Ripe, red fruits which stays clean. A welcome relief from shouty New World fruit-bombs.

Côtes du Rhone, Chateau Les Amoureuses, 'La Barbare', France 38.95

Deeply delicious, fruity and powerful, with immense smoothness and harmony and gentle warming spices.

Appassimento Alanera, Zenato, Italy 45.95

The bouquet is intense and complex with notes of red fruits and gentle spices. Dolcetto and Barbera - a match made in heaven!

Le Colombier, Massaya, Lebanon 36.95

Spicy notes with ripe, meaty, blackberry and red fruits, and a touch of chocolate.

Chateau Montaignillon, St Emilion, France 42.95

Soft and supple yet packed with rich dark fruit.

Ripasso Superiore, Zenato, Italy 54.95

Powerful, smooth and like all good Italian wines, superb with food. Often referred to as a baby 'Amarone'.

Château La Branne, Cru Bourgeois Supérieur, Medoc, France 49.95

Right bank meets left bank, lots of fruit, vanilla and gentle spices with fine tannins.

Zonin Amarone Della Valpolicella, Veneto, Italy 62.95

Majestic, powerful and silky smooth, this wine is something special!

Ventoux, Le Vin de Léonard, Rhône Valley, France 32.94

Ripe strawberry fruit, a touch of spice, soft supple tannins and a peppery finish.

Pinot Grigio Rose, Belvino, Italy 4.75 / 25.95

Pinot Grigio pink at its finest. Fresh flavours of raspberry and red cherry with a lifting finish.

White Zinfandel, Wicked Lady, California USA 4.55 / 24.95

Strawberries and cream in a glass. Living in 'zin' with this wicked lady.

Cinsault, Domaine de l'Olibet, Pays d'Oc, France 5.10 / 27.95

Classic, dry and elegant. Perfect for a sunny day!

Piquepoul Rose, Coteaux d'Enserune, Foccalieu France 34.95

Beautiful, delicate and fresh. With strawberries and cherry blossom on the nose.

Whispering Angel, Cotes De Provence, France 51.95
