White Wines

Chenin Blanc, Wide River, South Africa 4.35 / 23.75

Light, with lovely ripe, attractive rounded fruit. Fresh floral nose and an exciting acid balance. A beautifully finished, clean off-dry Chenin Blanc.

Pinot Grigio, Bella Modella, Italy 4.75 / 25.95

Light straw in colour. Fresh, citrus and apple flavours. Light in body with subtle mineral notes. A crisp, refreshing finish. Delicious Pinot Grigio!

Sauvignon Blanc, Goose Beret, New Zealand 6.00 / 32.95

With more texture than aromatics alone, this is a food-friendly Sauvignon Blanc from New Zealand.

Bright, crisp, and aromatic, with generous aromas of cut grass, tomato-leaf and asparagus over a tangy palate of citrus, bell-pepper and bay.

Chardonnay, Coorong Estate, Australia 4.55 / 24.95

Crisp, dry, and unoaked. This is deliciously fresh, showing stone fruits, citrus, melon, and a lovely racy finish.

Sauvignon Blanc, Paparuda, Romania 4.90 / 26.95

The palate is upfront and clean with zingy passionfruit, crisp grapefruit with subtle citrus, finishing dry and full of freshly cut grass, accompanied with undertones of gooseberry and tangerine.

Trebbiano, Fonte Forte, Italy 5.00 / 27.45

Straw yellow in colour with green hints. Fruity wine with notes of exotic fruits and white peach flowers. Medium bodied, delicate and fresh.

Pinot Gris, Kumeu Village, New Zealand 29.95

The fruit aromas of this wine are very floral and reminiscent of roses. The palate is characterised by a rich texture, making it especially good with food. The finish has a little more citrus fruit, giving freshness and elegance.

Gavi Di Gavi, Conte Di Alari, Italy 6.75 / 39.95

Straw yellow in colour with subtle green reflections. A delicately aromatic and soft nose precedes a crisp and floral palate with peachy undertones and well-balanced structure.

Chardonnay, Montagny Maison Roche de Bellene 2020, France 7.50 / 44.95

This wine punches well above its weight and village level. It has bright fruits and a nice purity. A delicious Montagny made from vineyards on sloping hillsides. It was bought as grapes and 80% was fermented in tank, 20% in 600-litre barrels. Bright, fresh and floral, 2020 was historically early and regarded as a great vintage – excellent stuff!

Alberino, Sandboy, Spain 42.95

The nose has lovely citrus fruits and fresh cut grass. On the palate there is ripe stone fruits, good texture with refreshing acidity and a touch of spice on the finish.

Orvieto Classico Superiore DOC 'Mare Antico', Decugnano Dei Barbi, Italy 39.95

Straw yellow in colour with greenish highlights. The nose reveals hints of fresh white fruit with deep mineral textures. On the palate, it is characterised by a lively acidity with a savoury touch, an ample and persistent freshness.

Sancerre, Roger Naudet & Fils, France 49.95

Sancerre is a renowned region of the Loire's Central Vineyards, famous for some of the world's finest Sauvignon Blanc. The Naudet family have been grape growers there for five generations and have slowly built up 16 hectares of vineyards. Intense and finely textured, with citrus, gunflint and racy freshness.

Soave, Zenato, Italy 37.95

This is a ripe, fruit-forward Soave classico, with a rich, rounded texture, though supported and lifted by refreshing acids. I like the flavours of ripe peaches, apricots, grapefruit, and hints of melon here, and the long, refreshingly zesty finish.

Pouilly-Fuissé, Domaine Les Vieux Murs 2022, France 52.95

The first sip of Domaine Les Vieux Murs is a revelation. The vibrant acidity cuts through the initial burst of ripe orchard fruits, mirroring the aromas detected on the nose. This delightful interplay creates a lively and refreshing dance on the palate. The wine boasts a lovely weight and texture, with a subtle creaminess that adds depth without overwhelming the senses. It's a perfect balance – rich yet refreshing, full-bodied yet elegant.

Chassagne Montrachet, Les Champgains 1er Cru, France 75.00

Chassagne-Montrachet itself is a village in the Cote de Beaune sub-region of Burgundy with its own communal appellation, created in 1937. Good energy here, a respectable and well-made white with flavours of pineapple, nectarine, Satsumas and ginger stem.

Rosé wine

Pinot Grigio Blush, Bella Modella, Italy 4.75 / 25.95

Pinot Grigio pink at its finest. Fresh flavours of raspberry and red cherry with a lifting finish.

Zinfandel Rosé, Wicked Lady, California 4.45 / 24.45

Medium-sweet rosé made using Zinfandel grapes from warm Californian vineyards. Shows red fruits on the rich, juicy palate.

Provence Rosé, Domaine Pey Blanc No.1, France 6.55 / 35.95

The rosé of the best holidays! Elegance, freshness, and finesse. Bright, pale colour, aromas of exotic fruits, citrus fruits, white flowers.

Bardolino Chiaretto, Zenato, Italy 42.95

A great blend of Corvina, Rondinella and Merlot grapes. An exceptional claret, in which the natural freshness of this wonderful, mineral and intriguing rosé, takes advantage of the roundness of the Merlot and the structure of the Amarone grapes. A great Garda claret, which also tells of the Valpolicella tradition and boasts at the same time a modern and international touch.

Champagne

Laurent Perrier is one of the finest names in Champagne. The house was created in 1812 by Alphonse Pierlot and sold to the Nonancourt family in 1939. It has since become one of the most famous of the Grandes Marques Champagnes and is also the region's largest family-owned house. Now on to the 3rd generation within the family.

Red Wines

Pinot Noir, Păpăruța, Romania 4.55 / 24.95

Fragrant and fruity Pinot Noir with plenty of ripe red fruits, strawberries, and raspberries, fresh and crunchy with hints of spice.

Merlot, Tanners, France 5.20 / 27.95

A deliciously soft and fruity wine with lots of juicy, plummy flavours. This is nursery slope vino with no hard edges and a very moreish quality that gets you back for another bottle!

Rioja, De Alto, Spain 5.10 / 27.95

Aromatic and intense with lovely aromas of wild red berries, blossom and hints of sandalwood. Fresh, fruity and well balanced with sensations of raspberries, vanilla and cinnamon. A wine with great purity and depth of fruit with gentle oak.

Shiraz, The Opportunist, Australia 6.00 / 32.95

An energetic, vibrant nose of delicious, herbal cassis and spice followed by a succulent palate of dark fruits, mocha and grilled meats. Lovely balance: intense yet not over-powering - just how we like Aussie Shiraz.

Malbec, Gougenheim Malbec, Uco Valley, Tupungato, Argentina 6.00 / 32.95

Plenty of rich dark fruit flavours or ripe black plums, cherries, and a note of liquorice. Supple tannins on the palate and more rounded fruit character with a long finish.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Casa Santiago, Chile 4.80 / 26.95

A ruby red colour and bright highlights. Intense aromas of strawberry and raspberry with a hint of dark chocolate. Pleasant and lively mouth entry, medium-bodied and with well-integrated tannins on the finish.

Montepulciano, Fonte Forte, Italy 5.00 / 27.45

Red ruby in colour. Fresh, fruity and pleasant on the palate. Medium bodied, with good sapidity. Great wine for this time of the year.

Dornfelder, Rietburg, Pfalz, Germany 5.45 / 29.95

In the glass it is a strong garnet red. On the nose it has fruity aromas of blackberries and ripe cherries. On the palate it is dense with a dominant body. The finish is slightly spicy, and the fruity nuances give it a lovely aftertaste.

Carignan, Vigno, Dry Farmed Old Vine, Undurraga, Chile 8.00 / 44.95

A very fresh Carignan blend (88% Carignan; 12% Cinsault) with strong finishing thrust and lingering spiciness. Deep, dark coloured wine. Enticingly intense fresh wild berry, red and blue cherry aromas, sweet herbal notes and hints of earthiness. Vigno Carignan has a refined and vibrant palate with concentrated red fruit flavours, structured ripe tannins and long persistence.

Ripassa Valpolicella, Zenato, Italy 49.95

This red wine from Veneto is juicy and supple and its compact fruit is complemented by subtle notes of coffee, liquorice and almond and carried into a long, noble finale.

Shiraz, Journeys End V3 Single Vineyard, South Africa 49.95

Ripe raspberry aromas with peppery spice and a hint of chocolate on the nose. The palate is big fresh and full of life with heaps of red berry fruit and a delicious vanilla edge to the long finish.

Pinot Noir, Volnay, Vieilles Vignes, Maison Roche de Bellene, France 49.95

Framboise and wild strawberry aromas. Spicy with a good concentration of fruit and attractive firm tannins and mouthfeel. Seductive stuff!

Celler de l'Abadia, Sant Jeroni Hort, Priorat, Spain 42.95

Priorat wine is famous for its deep, bold characteristics, with flavours of ripe red cherries, black stone fruits, and rich baking spices. Its iconic terraced landscape is dotted with old bush vines of the most well-known Priorat grapes - Garnacha and Carignan.

Barbaresco, Staderi, Renato Fenocchio 2019 69.95

Renato Fenocchio Staderi Barbaresco is an excellent wine, with an intensely garnet red colour, the scent is ethereal and harmonic, fruity even austere; the taste is full and dry and the sweet tannin makes it nicely velvety.

Tanners Super Claret, Moulis-en-Médoc 2018, France 46.95

Our latest Super Claret is made by the Barton family of Léoville and Langoa Barton. It has lovely, sweet fruit with excellent balance and weight. A classic claret from an excellent vintage. A Merlot-based blend from an outstanding year, it's already in its precocious prime and you'd be hard-pressed to find its equal.

Cabernet Sauvignon / Montepulciano / Syrah, Decugnano Dei Barbi, AD 1212, Italy 54.95

AD 1212 is a special edition, dedicated to the first written records of winemaking at Decugnano. Ruby red in colour, it reveals an array of red fruits and spices on the nose, with a marked note of black pepper. The palate is rich in intense black fruit, tannins are soft yet structured, supported by a good level of acidity and well-integrated alcohol. Intense and savoury, a wine of powerful elegance.

Barbaresco, Rombone, Renato Fenocchio 2018 59.95

Very sleek and fine, this has aromas of rose petals, then strawberries and raspberries on the palate with a mouth-watering juiciness. Renato and Milva Fenocchio make a gorgeous range of wines at their small estate in Barbaresco.



Amarone Classico della Valpolicella DOCG, Zenato, Italy 13.25 / 79.95

Deep ruby-red. Strong note of herbs, quinine and roasted red fruit on the nose. Then fresher and cleaner with lovely floral flavours of red cherry and spicy herbs. Finishes long with youthfully chewy tannins.

Château Cambon La Pelouse, Haut-Médoc 2015, France 79.95

Château Cambon La Pelouse 2015 is an excellent Cru Bourgeois from a great vintage. Cabernet-dominant, this has blackberry, fresh coffee and plum, well-integrated oak and ripe tannins.

'Seruci', Carignano Del Sulcis Riserva, Enrico Esu 2018, Italy 89.95

Pure old vine Carignan from ungrafted vines averaging 62 years of age. Very traditionally made with little intervention in the winery and the results are full flavoured and stunning. Medium bodied, this Sardinian wine is named after the mine Silvio, Enrico's Father, worked in.

Amarone Riserva 2017, Zenato, Italy 125.00

Sergio Zenato's personal Riserva Amarone is something special. We've been stocking it for years and enjoyed many great vintages. It is the one wine we turn to when we decide to treat ourselves to a special wine. Aromas of espresso, black pepper, oak and chocolate.

"Turriga" Isola dei Nuraghi IGT 2019 · MAGNUM 175.00

It has a deep ruby red colour and an enveloping taste of almost spherical softness, with tannins of great finesse that support and accompany the drink. The lively fruit is supported by a balanced acidity and spiciness that refreshes the palate and prolongs an indescribable finish of rare elegance.
