Colombard Sauvignon, Crusan, France. £5.25 / 20.95

Fresh but succulent, this is a juicy little quaffer with a soft attack, late fruit and a clean finish.

Sea Point, Sauvignon Blanc, South Africa. £5.50 / 21.95

A fresh white wine with aromas and flavours of fresh cut grass, ripe peaches and gooseberries.

Quindi, Pinot Grigio, Italy. £6.00 / 23.95

Lovely citrus taste with a hint of crisp green apple, pairs wonderfully with lighter food options.

Milford Point, Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand. £7.25 / 28.95

A corker of a Sauvignon Blanc, with a good squeeze of lemon and bags of tropical fruit

Chardonnay, The Listening Station, Australia. £5.50 / 21.95

Quintessentially Australian, unoaked with tangerine, grapefruit, lime and a hint of spice.

Viognier, Baron de Badassier VDP, France. £5.75 / 22.95

This Viognier is made in a fresh modern style, but keeping the elegance of an Old World wine

Picpoul De Pinet, Jean-Luc Colombo, Les Girelles, France 26.95

Bone-dry with great textures. If you enjoy a crisp Sauvignon this will float your boat

Rag and Bone Riesling, Australia 29.95

Dry, textural, limey, quite simply everything you want from an Aussie Riesling.

Albariño Raimat, Spain 27.95

Spanish señorita dances on your palate with a kick of zippy citrus, almond and sweet vanilla.

Sileni Straights, Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand 34.95

A classic regional style, this wine has intensely aromatic gooseberry and passionfruit flavours. The palate is rich and full with a long finish

Gavi, Araldica, Italy 25.95

Known for dry, lemony wines this is fermented in steel tanks to give a clear and elegant flavour.

Sauvignon Blanc, Domaine De Vedilhan, France 24.95

Nose-prickingly crisp, with refreshing hints of lime in the mouth.

Kardos Dry Furmint, Hungary 28.95

The Furmint grape from Hungary, fermented to dry. Aromatic, herbal, true perfection...

Pinot Grigio Rosato delle Venezie, Belvino, Italy. £6.00 / 23.95

Pinot Grigio pink at its finest. Fresh flavours of raspberry and red cherry with a lifting finish.

White Zinfandel, Wicked Lady, California, USA. £5.75 / 22.95

Strawberries and cream in a glass. Living in 'zin' with this wicked lady.

Domaine de L'Olibet 'Les Pujols' Cinsault Rosé, Pays d'Oc, Languedoc France. £6.25 / 24.95

Classic, dry and elegant, a true foodie Rose.

Nero d'Avola, Solandia, Sicily. £5.25 / 20.95

A proper Italian quaffer with bags of character - excellent on its own or with food.

Merlot, Granfort, Pays D'oc, France. £5.50 / 21.95

Soft, rounded plummy fruit flavours with a gentle sustained finish. A cuddle in a glass.

Rare Vineyards Pinot Noir, France. £6.00 / 23.95

If wine were footwear this would be a light summer deck shoe. Red cherries spring to mind.

Malbec, Tanners, Argentina. £5.85 / 23.25

Juicy, open nose, full and ripe palate with lovely black and red fruits and an appealing fresh character.

Excelsior, Robertson, Shiraz. £5.75 / 22.95

Strong, robust and dependable with dark, warm, cherry and violet notes and a nice hit of pepper.

Don Jacobo, Rioja, Spain. £6.25 / 25.95

Delicious Rioja. Deep colour, ripe plum and cherry fruit aromas with a smoky dimension.

Fiorbella Rosso Appassimento, Rosso Del Vento, Italy 26.95

Intense ruby-red, bags of dark cherry, dried fruit, soft and round thanks to American and French Oak

Artesa Organic Rioja, Spain 28.95

Fresh redcurrant and cherry aromas with woody, herbal notes.

The Guv'nor, Felix Solis, Spain 23.95

If Ray Winston met Marlon Brando, this is what they would drink. Moody with bags of attitude.

The Cloud Factory Pinot Noir, Marlborough, New Zealand 29.95

From the coast of the Southern Ocean it's a quirkier more vibrant wine than its French cousin.

Boutinot 'Les Coteaux' Côtes du Rhône Villages, France 25.95

A real gem of a wine. Fruity and powerful, with immense smoothness and harmony.

Chateau de Fleurie, Loron, Beaujolais, France 29.95

Ripe, red fruits which stays clean, A welcome relief from shouty New World fruit-bombs.

Sanama, Red Blend Chile 23.95
