#### White Wines

# Colombard/Sauvignon, Crusan, France 4.40 / 23.95

Fresh but succulent, this is a juicy little quaffer with a soft attack, late fruit and a clean finish. Great House white! **Pinot Grigio, Bella Modella, Italy** 4.75 / 25.95

Light straw in colour. Fresh, citrus and apple flavours. Light in body with subtle mineral notes. A crisp, refreshing finish. Delicious Pinot Grigio!

# Sauvignon Blanc, Greenhough, New Zealand 6.50 / 35.95

Intense aromas of those classic grassy, gooseberry and tropical fruit flavours that have made 'Kiwi' Sauvignon Blanc world famous.

# Chardonnay, Listening Station, Australia 4.55 / 24.95

Listening Station Chardonnay is made from a Chardonnay clone that originates from Mendoza, this always shows prominent tangerine notes on the nose, and this vintage also shows intense grapefruit, lime and hints of spice.

Refreshingly unoaked.

# Sauvignon Blanc, Tierra Alta, Chile 4.55 / 24.95

A fresh and crisp wine with ripe citrus fruit. Packed with lime zest, lemon and kiwi fruit flavours. Think of cool glacial streams and enjoy the refreshing, racy acidity on the finish.

# Chardonnay, Réserve Personnelle Mâcon-Villages, France 6.40 / 34.95

Signature house style - unoaked, elegant and showing characteristics typical of southern Burgundian Chardonnay. This wine shows elegance, finesse and style.

# Château Lafont Menaut Blanc, Pessac Leognan 2018 49.95

Philibert Perrin, also owner of Château Carbonnieux, produces full, rich wines with good structure. Oak-aged, this has plenty of fresh Sauvignon fruit and lovely depth to finish.

# Gavi Di Gavi, Conte Di Alari, Italy 34.95

Bright yellow colour, delicate bouquet of dried pineapple and peach. Full and rich in flavour, mineral and refreshing. Fine aromatic flavour to the end.

# Sauvignon Blanc, Earth Song, New Zealand 44.95

Rich, flavoursome sauvignon with passionfruit, cut grass, green capsicum and tomato leaf flavours. Weighty, complex wine with good mouthfeel and a lingering finish.

# Douro Branco, Golpe Reserva, Carvalho Martins 2020, Portugal 44.95

Intense tropical and citrus fruit aromas, intertwined with floral and mineral notes. Tropical and citrus flavours with a mineral streak on the beautifully refreshing palate. Well structured with a long finish.

# Soave, Zenato, Italy 29.95

Zenato is a superb single vineyard Classico Soave. A blend of Chardonnay and Garganega from a single vineyard, hand picked, soft pressed and fermented under temperature control. A lovely full flavoured wine from the Zenato family. Recommended.

# Via Magna Rulandské Sedé (Pinot Gris), Juznoslovenská, Slovakia 2021 34.95

Full and rich with a soft, silky character and a touch of smokiness. Good freshness too on the finish.

# Domaine Les Vieux Murs, Pouilly-Fuissé, France 52.95

This appellation is often overlooked, a crime! An intense mineral and citrus character with strong hints of complex nutty, buttery flavours. Very well balanced with crisp acidity and good texture.

# Chassagne Montrachet, Les Champgains 1er cru, 2021, France 85.00

This premier cru is a real treat from the Pillot family- grown in limestone-clay hills in Burgundy. The palate is warming, yet pure, concentrated and balanced with white fruit and peach carried by discreet oak notes. It is an elegant wine with remarkable minerality and amazing length on the finish.

# Châteauneuf-du-Pape Blanc, Domaine Du Vieux Télégraphe, Famille Brunier 2019, France 115.95

A powerful, generous white made in very limited quantities. Lemon, dried apricots, pear and honey on the nose with hints of beeswax. A full and complex palate, mostly citrus fruits and touches of mineral and hazelnut.

# Familia Carvalho Martins, Douro Meda, 2019, Portugal 92.95

Intense tropical and citrus fruit aromas, intertwined with floral and mineral notes. Tropical and citrus flavours with a mineral streak on the beautifully refreshing palate. Well-structured with a long finish.

# Chardonnay, Alain Gras, St-Romain 2020, France 69.95

Regarded as one of the best producers in Saint-Romain their wines currently adorn the wine lists in nearly every single Michelin 3 star restaurant in France (21 of 26 at last count!) Rich aromas of ripe white stone fruits, citrus, and hints of nuts, toast and vanilla beans. Bursting with finesse.

# Fizz

# Prosecco, Il Baco, Italy 7.50 / 26.95

This fizz is extra dry and full of subtle flavours. As it's name suggests, this is a soft fizz, perfect for accompanying lighter dishes - think seafood & salads. It has green apple & pear notes, with a silky honey finish!

# Pierre Mignon Grande Reserve Premier Cru Brut NV, France 9.95 / 49.95

A crisp, well-balanced champagne with citrus hints on the nose overlaid with touches of brioche and yeastiness.

The palate is fresh, clean and lively with a creamy mousse and long finish.

# Gosset Grande Reserve Brut NV, Champagne. France 85.00

Gosset have been making wine in Aÿ since 1584. This is their flagship Champagne and a showcase for their elegant house style. A bright and crisp wine with very precise mouthfeel, pinhead bubbles and a fine, toasty finish.

# Champagne, Bollinger Special Cuvée, France 89.95

Instantly recognisable and a real favourite with our customers, this celebrated Champagne displays a wealth of toasty richness and tiny pin-prick bubbles - the hallmark of the very finest fizz.

# Nyetimber Blanc de Blancs, UK 79.95

Light gold hue and a fine, delicate mousse. Aromas of lemon sherbet and honeysuckle lead into fresh pastry and vanilla characters. The palate is rounded and soft, offering generous yet elegant notes of green apple, lemon zest, orange blossom, and chamomile.

# Nero D'avola, Solandia, Italy 4.40 / 23.95

Nero d'Avola is a grape variety native to Sicily. With its dark, ripe-berried fruit and a hint of liquorice and vanilla spice - just in time for the colder days.

#### Merlot, Tanners, France 5.20 / 27.95

A deliciously soft and fruity wine with lots of juicy, plummy flavours. This is nursery slope vino with no hard edges and a very moreish quality that gets you back for another bottle!

# **Rioja, De Alto, Spain** 4.90 / 26.95

A characterful, classic Rioja with just a touch of oak - masterfully blended and shaped in the way of our team - approachable, honest and loveable!

# Shiraz/Mourvedre, Percheron, South Africa 4.55 / 24.95

A bright, sandy nose that suggests summer pudding, Chinese 5 spice and crushed raspberries with a latent creaminess. Red fruit on the palate which is at once vibrant and dark.

# Malbec, Man Meets Mountain, Argentina 5.00 / 27.45

Great things are done when men and mountains meet, this is not done by jostling in the street. From the heights of the Andes mountains we have this harmonious Malbec, packed full of blueberry, blackcurrant and plum and a complex and delicious finish.

# Pinot Noir, Rare Vineyards, France 4.55 / 24.95

Smooth, velvety palate which shows cherry and blueberry flavours backed with a hint of sweet oak spice close to the Pyrénées Mountains.

# Valpolicella, Zenato, Italy 6.20 / 33.95

Zenato are one of the Veneto region's best producers and members of the elite Amarone Consortium. All their wines are high quality. This wine is very smooth with great fruit and a long finish.

# Appassimento, Piemonte Dezzani, Italy 6.45 / 35.95

Bright ruby red in colour. The bouquet is intense and complex with notes of red fruits and gentle spices. In the mouth the wine is full, soft, velvety and really harmonic. Dolcetto and Barbera – a match made in heaven!

# Barbera Elisa, La Colombera, Italy 32.95

This wine comes from the oldest vineyard of La Colombera. Intense ruby red with red fruits typical of the Vho hills - blackberries, cherries, plums, jam, spices with notes of vanilla too!

#### Yerevan, winemaker's blend, 2022, Armenia 32.95

Yerevan is one of the world's oldest cities and wine-producing areas founded in 782 BC. Native Areni and Karmrahyut grapes are hand harvested from highland vineyards at 1000-1500m above sea level. Versatile with expressive aromas of dark cherry, spices, raspberry, strawberry jam, dried fruit and nuts.

# Langhe Nebbiolo, Tibaldi, Italy 44.95

Full of warm fruit, full and juicy with herb and liquorice flavours. Excellent purity of fruit character, soft and ripe tannins and good balancing freshness. Smooth and silky.

# Rioja Vega, '9 Barricas' Crianza, Rioja 2017 69.95

Dark garnet colour, soft in the mouth, balanced and clean on the finish with good length. This wine is aged on its lees for 9 months in French oak, giving it a mix of spice and toasty oak overlay, plum, and cassis fruit.

#### Celler de l'Abadia, Sant Jeroni Hort, Priorat, Spain 49.95

Priorat wine is famous for its deep, bold characteristics, with flavours of ripe red cherries, black stone fruits, and rich baking spices. Its iconic terraced landscape is dotted with old bush vines of the most well-known Priorat grapes - Garnacha and Carignan.

# Reserva Malbec, Don Manuel Villafane, Argentina 36.95

Purple hints of very good intensity. Delicious aromas of plums, morello cherry, truffle and, with ageing, chocolate and vanilla. Argentinian Malbec tends to enjoy mellower tannin to its French counterpart.

# Ripassa Valipolicella, Zenato, Italy 44.95

This red wine from Veneto is juicy and supple and its compact fruit is complemented by subtle notes of coffee, liquorice and almond and carried into a long, noble finale.

# Châteuneuf-du-Pape, Domaine Chante Cigale, France 59.95

Intense and inky dark, with a concentrated, rich and complex nose of kirsch, bay and graphite. Very full bodied and weighty with some evident tannins. Despite its heft, the old vines provide great complexity and interest and we are left with a lovely juice.

# Etna Rosso DOC "Alta Mora - Guardiola" 2016 - Cusumano, Sicily 61.95

Guardiola, a cru from Nerello Mascalese, shows the typical elegant aromatics from volcanic soils, with notes of black raspberry leading the way in this grippy, mineral-driven red. It's layered with accents of liquorice snap, sage, and orange peel.

# Amarone Classico della Valpolicella DOCG, Zenato 79.95

Deep ruby-red. Strong note of herbs, quinine and roasted red fruit on the nose. Then fresher and cleaner with lovely floral flavours of red cherry and spicy herbs. Finishes long with youthfully chewy tannins.

# Sesti 'Grangiovese', Toscana, Castello Di Argiano 2021, Italy 59.95

This Sangiovese based wine is brimming with sour cherries and strawberry fruit entwined with earthy notes and a dash of vanilla.

# Chianti Classico DOCG, Gran selezione 'Stielle' 2016 69.95

Ruby red colour, aromas of currants and raspberries, freshness and great drinkability. On the palate it is full-bodied and potent with good acidity and enveloping, crunchy tannins that make the wine elegant and easy to drink.

# Château Cambon La Pelouse, Haut-Médoc 2015 79.95

Château Cambon La Pelouse 2015 is an excellent Cru Bourgeois from a great vintage. Cabernet-dominant, this has blackberry, fresh coffee and plum, well-integrated oak and ripe tannins.

# Barolo, Roagna 2016, Italy 195.00

This 2016 Barolo is a gorgeous, complex wine endowed with terrific depth and tons of nuance that continues to open over time. Light on its feet and yet wonderfully deep, the 2016 has so much going on. Kirsch, sweet red cherry, spice, orange zest, menthol and spice fill out the layers effortlessly!

# 2018 Solaia, Antinori, Tuscany, Italy 425.00

Sweet scents of crème de cassis, lavender, graphite, mint, spice and espresso lead into a fine, delineated palate. Bright and energetic, Solaia is decidedly medium in body in 2018, with striking purity and exceptional beauty.

# Pinot Grigio Blush, Bella Modella, Italy 4.75 / 25.95

Pinot Grigio pink at its finest. Fresh flavours of raspberry and red cherry with a lifting finish.

# Zinfandel, Wicked Lady, California 4.45 / 24.45

Medium-sweet rosé made using Zinfandel grapes from warm Californian vineyards. Shows redfruits on the rich, juicy palate.

# Château Rochesoleil, Côtes de Provence, France 6.20 / 34.95

ight pink colour with orange hues. Intense nose opening on notes of wild fruit (raspberries) and pit fruits (plum). Supple and fruity mouthfeel with subtle flavours of white flesh fruits. Long finish; smooth with hints of cooked strawberries.

# Lady Elizabeth Rosé 2017, Coolhurst, UK 69.95

Our distinctive pale salmon colour sits alongside deliciously defined fruit. It's the full gamut of citrus to peach with red fruit scintillation. This wine is built to last and will benefit from extended cork aging, but nonetheless is also delicious!

# Champagne, Laurent-Perrier Cuvée Rosé Brut NV, France 89.95

The Cuvée Rosé Laurent-Perrier was created in 1968 and is now the benchmark in its category. Held in an elegant wine bottle inspired by King Henri IV. Pretty raspberry hints this fresh, crisp champagne shows flavours of strawberries, red-currants and raspberries.
