White Wines

Colombard Sauvignon, Crusan, France 4.00 / 21.95

Crisp, dry and refreshing. A perfect summer's day tipple.

Sauvignon Blanc, Tierra Alta, Chile 4.40 / 23.95

Fresh, ripe citrus fruit, with lime zest and kiwi fruit flavours, and a crisp racy finish.

Chardonnay, Listening Station, Australia 4.40 / 23.95

Refreshingly unoaked, citrus, white peach flavours combine with a zesty and a clean finish.

Sauvignon Blanc, Domaine de Vedilhan, France 4.70 / 25.75

Piercing gooseberry aromas, crushed limes on the palate, really crisp and refreshing.

Chenin Blanc, Bush Vines Kleine Zalze, South Africa 4.40 / 23.95

This beauty is bursting at the seams with zingy gooseberries and voluptuous tropical fruit.

Pinto Grigo, Quindi, Italy 4.55 / 24.95

A classic from Puglia. Soft apple aromas with a zesty lemon touch for that true Italian flair.

Sauvignon Blanc, Milford Point, New Zealand 5.45 / 29.95

A classic Marlborough Sauvignon, a textural mid-palate with fruit sweetness and a dry finish.

Gavi La Luciana, Araldica, Italy 5.15 / 28.25

A discovery wine from the foothills of Piedmont, crisp, dry and lemony.

Marsanne Viognier, Rare Vineyards, France 24.95

Rhone grapes go on holiday to the south of France! Fresh, peachy soft and rounded.

Albarino, Raimat, Spain 29.25

Light floral and zesty summer wine. Perfect for sitting in the sun with a light bite to eat.

Sancerre, Mellot, France 30.75

Expressive nose with notes of citrus fruits. Supple & delicate on the palate.

Riesling, Rag and Bone, Australia 32.25

The palate is bright and zingy, singing with natural acidity and vibrant citrus and floral characters. Lovely delicacy and purity of fruit lifted and a crisp, bracing finish.

Legende de Bordeaux Blanc, Barons de Rothschild, France 29.95

An aromatic and pleasant wine blending Semillon and Sauvignon grapes.

Chablis Premier Cru Beauroy, Domaine de la Motte, France 39.95

Old school aromatic buttery loveliness. A big shaggy dog of a wine that licks you all over.

White Zinfandel, Wicked Lady, California, USA 4.40 / 23.95

Luscious strawberry ice cream on the nose supported by a bring, berry fruited palate.

Pinot Grigio Rosato delle Venezie, Belvino, Italy 4.55 / 24.95

Pinot Grigio pink at its finest. Fresh flavours of raspberry and red cherry with a lifting finish.

Grenache Noir, Cotes de Thau, France 28.95

Rich currant flavours provided by Grenache and tangy raspberry from Cinsault before a dry and fresh finish.

Picquepoul Noir Rosé, Foncalieu, France 27.95

A charming strawberry scented Rosé with freshness and delicacy. Light easy drink from the South of France.

Nero d'Avola, Solandia, Sicily 4.00 / 21.95

A proper Italian quaffer with bags of character - excellent on its own or with food.

Shiraz Mourverdre, Percheron, South Africa 4.40 / 23.95

Strong, robust and dependable with dark, warm, chocolatey notes and a big savoury heart.

Merlot, Peculiar Mr Pat, Australia 4.55 / 24.95

Bright, plush, deeply tasty Merlot from Riverland vineyards, this is abundant in freshly picked red fruit with a soft tannic profile and a long, moreish finish.

Tempranillo, The Gov'nor, Spain 4.45 / 24.45

Made to a fruit-driven style it shows notes of vanilla from a short period of oak ageing.

Pinot Noir, Rare Vineyards, France 4.55 / 24.95

If wine were footwear this would be a light summer deck shoe. Red cherries spring to mind.

Malbec, Tesoro De Los Andes, Argentina 4.75 / 25.95

The nose offers an appealing, bramble fruit followed by dark, damson and savoury overtones on the palate.

Rioja, Vega del Rayo, Spain 4.75 / 25.95

A modern, vibrant, unoaked tempranillo. Pure juicy red fruits, hints of black pepper and spice.

Cabernet Sauvignon Gran Reserva, Luis Felipe Edwards, Chile 4.45 / 24.45

A lively, ruby red wine with soft, elegant tannins and toasty oak notes.

Red Zinfandel, Big Top, California, USA 26.25

Aromas of vanilla, cracked black pepper and dark damson fruit.

Cotes du Rhone Villages, Les Coteaux, France 27.95

A real gem of a wine. Fruity and powerful, with immense smoothness and harmony.

Bordeaux, Chateau Buisson Redon, France 28.95

The palate is medium-bodied and structured with round, warm fruit and a velvety finish.

Rioja, Artesa Organic, Spain 31.25

Fresh redcurrant and cherry aromas with woody, herbal notes.

Fleurie, Chateau de Fleurie, Loron, France 30.95

Ripe and savoury strawberry, cherry & raspberry fruit. Clean and supple throughout.

Pinot Noir, Cloud Factory, New Zealand 33.25

Classic cranberry and red current aromas gives a wine with bite and texture.

Malbec, Ojos Del Sur, Argentina 31.95

Vibrant and fruity, plums, raspberries, blackberries but also a more subtle floral note of violets.

Amarone Della Valpolicella, Montresor, Italy 56.95

Rich and warming yet fresh and well-balanced, with supple tannins and a rich texture.

The fuel of gondoliers, water-taxi drivers and romances of Venice. Happy bubbles. Ciao bella!

Brut Rosado Cava, Castellblanc, Spain 7.95 / 27.95

Salmon-pink with initial notes of bramble & blackcurrant fruit followed by a hint of baked bread.

Champagne, Louis Dornier, France 39.95

A light, fresh, youthful Champagne with a fine, elegant, slightly lemony nose, lively mousse, long, crisp palate.

Champagne, Veuve Cliquot, France 50.95

Mouthwatering fruit, a splendid mousse and a tremendous finish - what's not to love?
