White Wines

Chenin Blanc, Wide River, South Africa 6.25 / 23.95

Clean and bright Chenin Blanc, peppery and aromatic, with tropical fruit flavours of ripe fig and melon backed up with crisp, refreshing acidity. Perfect house white!

Pinot Grigio, Sentito, Italy 6.75 / 25.95

Light straw in colour. Fresh, citrus and apple flavours. Light in body with subtle mineral notes. A crisp, refreshing finish. Delicious Pinot Grigio!

Sauvignon Blanc, Goose Beret, New Zealand 8.50 / 32.95

With more texture than aromatics alone, this is a food-friendly Sauvignon Blanc from New Zealand.

Bright, crisp, and aromatic, with generous aromas of cut grass, tomato-leaf and asparagus over a tangy palate of citrus, bell-pepper and bay.

Chardonnay, El Campesino, Central Valley, Chile 6.50 / 25.95

Crisp, dry, and unoaked. This is deliciously fresh, showing stone fruits, citrus, melon, and a lovely racy finish.

Chardonnay, Paparuda, Romania 6.25 / 24.95

A soft, but full and fruity distinctive chardonnay with a great freshness and lovely texture. Hints of oaked character, without any touching it.

Fiano, 'Muccchietto', Puglia, Italy 8.50 / 33.95

Aromas of nectarines, honeysuckle, tropical fruit and almonds combine with floral notes on the nose. The palate is round and crisp, with a twist on the finish that makes it just delicious.

Sauvignon Blanc, Paparuda, Romania 6.75 / 25.95

Racy citrus notes dominate the palate of this bracingly crisp dry white. Grapefruit with touches of blackcurrant and guava dominate the palate leading through to a zesty mouth-watering finish.

Torrontes, Anko, Estancia Los Cardones 2023, Argentina 8.25 / 32.95

Grown 1800m above sea level in Salta, a mountainous desert, making it one of the highest grown wines in South America. An elegant wine with good fruit concentration, a savoury hint and great, fresh minerality.

Rioja Blanco, 'Cueva De Lobos', Javier San Pedro Ortega Spain 8.00 / 30.95

Straw yellow with greenish reflections, very bright. On the nose, varietal aromas and fruity intensity. Floral nuances with citric notes. Tropical fruit aromas stand out: banana, pineapple and melon.

Montagny, Maison Roche de Bellene 2019, France 49.95

100% chardonnay from Burgundy. An attractive and exotic peachy nose. On the palate a lovely mix of rounded greengage plum fruit with zesty grapefruit and a hint of saline on the finish.

Sancerre, Domaine de la Grande Maison Chaumeau-Balland 2023, France 56.00

A fantastic Sauvignon Blanc in true Loire style, great minerality with stone fruits and chamomile coming through from a small family run winery in the village of Bué.

Domaine Pey Blanc 'Pluriel' White, Coteaux d'Aix-en-Provence 2022 39.95

Not as renowned for its white wines as its rose, this beautiful white is a shining example from Provence. Floral and creamy with citrus and peach flavours on the palate and an attractive freshness to give balance. Elegant and long.

Dry Riesling, Trocken, Peter Jakob Kühn, Rheingau 2022, Germany 39.95

This is a soft, attractive open wine with juicy apricot fruit sourced from Kühn's 18 hectares of vineyards in Hallgarten and Oestrich. Easy and accessible, this is an ideal introduction to dry German wine. Organic wine too!

Ianthis Chardonnay, Quinta do Francês, Algarve 2020, Portugal 59.95

A lovely soft, approachable Chardonnay from the Algarve, with a touch of pineapple and a hint of ginger. It is well-balanced with a lovely freshness and a gently spicy note on the finish. My pick of their whites from my visit in the summer, beautifully structured!

Vinho Branco Númbero 1 – Invincible, Portugal 49.95

The Invincible impresses with its fresh and fruity style, which is preserved by aging in stainless steel tanks, highlighting the fresh aromas of grapefruit and pear, from one of the best wine growing regions in Portugal.

Chablis, Domaine Vincent Dampt 2023, France 64.95

Rich, buttery- an absolute delight to drink! Minerality and soft fruits balanced expertly.

Heidi Schröck & Söhne Furmint, Austria 39.95

Golden yellow colour, the Heidi Schröck & Söhne Furmint has a unique profile with aromas of golden apple and quince as well as delicate notes of chamomile and hay. The palate is beautifully textured and crisp with a concentrated finish.

Sauvignon Blanc, Livon, Italy 44.95

Straw yellow in colour, with golden and greenish reflections. Its bouquet, intense and characteristic, recalls exotic fruit, melon and yellow peppers. A wide range of aromas are very well balanced. On the palate it is dry, with a good structure, generous.

Albariño, Sandboy, Spain 34.95

This is simply beautiful, well balanced, juicy stone fruits and a lush acidity. Takes you to sitting on a Spanish coastline with every sip, and a stunning bottle adds to the experience.

Sparkling

Prosecco, Cantina del Garda, Italy 8.45 / 29.95

An authentic Italian sparkling wine with vibrant fruit aromas, crisp, fresh palate. Perfect, happy bubbles.

Nyetimber Classic Cuvée, English Sparkling Wine, England 54.95

This tastes and looks like Champagne with a lovely biscuity nose and rich creamy flavours on the palate. From one of England's top estates this classic Champagne blend is certainly good enough to rival some of the best champagne houses.

Veuve Clicquot, Yellow Label Brut, France 64.95

The Yellow Label has been a guarantee of quality for centuries as the signature champagne of the House.

Laurent Perrier La Cuvée Champagne France 74.95

A crisp, well-balanced champagne with citrus hints on the nose overlaid with touches of brioche and yeastiness. The palate is fresh, clean and lively with a creamy mousse and long finish.

Champagne, Laurent-Perrier Cuvée Rosé Brut NV, France 84.95

The Cuvée Rosé Laurent-Perrier was created in 1968 and is now the benchmark in its category. Held in an elegant wine bottle inspired by King Henri IV.

Nyetimber Rosé, English Sparkling Wine, England 75.95

Full of class and finesse with a style and character remarkably similar to Champagne. Wonderfully elegant strawberry fruit with a crisp finish.

Taittinger Brut Rosé NV, France 69.95

Ultimately elegant, pink bubbles from Reims. A delicate pink salmon colour, it gives off aromas of red fruit (freshly crushed wild raspberry, cherry and blackcurrant).

Nyetimber Blanc de Blancs, English Sparkling Wine 2016, England 79.95

100% Chardonnay with very pure white fruit with delicious, elegant floral notes. The palate is characterful but shows tremendous finesse and a fine persistent finish. A great vintage, and the perfect time to drink.

Nyetimber 1086 Prestige Cuvée, English Sparkling Wine 2013, England 280.00

1086 by Nyetimber is made from the best parcels from only the most exceptional of vintage years. Elegance, structure, and complexity balanced in perfect harmony. The 2013 is fine pale-gold in hue, with a complex and rich nose of fruit and floral characters, including notes of red apple, peach and white rose petals.

Balfour Brut Rosé 2018 (Magnum) Kent, England 149.95

More cranberry than strawberry, this is classic Balfour; dry, precise and powerful. Richer than some of its predecessors, the 2018 reflects one of the best years in English viticultural history. A complex wine that is more than just primary fruit, there are notes of burnt orange combined with a wonderful herbaceous note on the finish.

Red Wines

Sangiovese, Finco Grande, Poderi dal Nespoli, Italy 6.25 / 23.95

A roper Italian quaffer with bags of character- excellent on its own or with food.

Merlot, Tanners, France 7.25 / 27.95

A deliciously soft and fruity wine with lots of juicy, plummy flavours. This is nursery slope vino with no hard edges and a very moreish quality that gets you back for another bottle!

Shiraz, Remi & Jérôme, Pays d'Oc, France 6.75 / 26.95

A full and spicy shiraz with blackberry and damson flavours. This is full of soft, juicy fruit from vineyards to the north of Narbonne. It is unoaked, has plenty of Southern French warmth, and reflects the best of modern varietals.

Tempranillo, The Guv'nor, Felix Solis, Spain 6.50 / 24.95

If Ray Winstone met Marlon Brando, this is what they'd drink. Moody with bags of attitude.

Malbec, Tanners Malbec, Argentina 7.50 / 28.95

Juicy & full with a ripe mouthful taste, notes of black and red fruits with an appealing fresh character make this an ideal all-rounder.

Pinot Noir, Sanziana, Romania 6.75 / 26.95

Bright and juicy, full of fresh fruit flavours from vines said to be some of the oldest in the world. Soft tannins make this extremely drinkable, with a subtle hint of spice.

Valpolicella Superiore DOC, Zenato, Italy 35.95

The wine has a ruby red colour, a delicate bouquet reminiscent of cherries and wild berries. The wine is medium to full-bodied and dry with a velvety finish.

Ripassa Valpolicella, Zenato, Italy 45.95

This red wine from Veneto is juicy and supple and its compact fruit is complemented by subtle notes of coffee, liquorice and almond and carried into a long, noble finale.

Refosco, Dal Peduncolo Rosso, Livon, Italy 39.95

Garnet-red with violet reflections, it has an intense and pleasant bouquet. Herbaceous notes with hints of blackberry. Full bodied with a long, pleasant aftertaste.

Sesti 'Grangiovese', Toscana, Castello di Argiano 2022, Italy 44.95

A stunning Sangiovese from the well renowned Sesti family. This is a brilliant introduction into the world of 'Super Tuscans', and personally one of my favourite red wines!

Château Musar, Bekaa Valley, Gaston Hochar, 2017, Lebanon £85.00

From the legendary estate- Full of ripe fruit, cherries, blackcurrants and cranberries with liquorice notes. More earthy, brambly fruit on the palate with blackberries, blueberries and cherries amongst the spice.

Shiraz, Samartzis 'S', Central Greece 39.95

Aromas of blackberries with hints of cinnamon and white pepper, leading to a soft fruity palette with wild strawberry and a characteristically peppery finish.

Amarone Classico della Valpolicella DOCG, Zenato, Italy 84.95

Deep ruby-red. Strong note of herbs, quinine and roasted red fruit on the nose. Then fresher and cleaner with lovely floral flavours of red cherry and spicy herbs. Finishes long with youthfully chewy tannins. Stunning quality from an exceptional producer.

Château Beauchêne Châteauneuf-du-Pape Grande Réserve 2022, France 82.95

A blend of Grenache (80%), Syrah (15%) and Mourvèdre (5%) sourced from vines that are over 100 years old. A concentrated and delicious example of Châteauneuf-du-Pape with spicy aromas and rich peppery palate that is perfectly balanced.

Fleurie, Château Fleurie, Domaine Loron, France 44.95

This is the queen of Beaujolais- fruity with intense aromas of blackcurrants, blackberries and dark chocolate. Rich and well balanced.

Primitivo, 'Mucchietto', Puglia, Italy 37.45

Fresh red cherry, with a hint of sweet spice on the nose, the palate is crammed with juicy plums and blueberries, cinnamon and vanilla, with dark chocolate. The wine has velvety tannins and an uplifting fresh finish to balance the rich fruit

Rioja Crianza, 'Cueva de Lobos', Javier San Pedro Ortega, Spain 33.95

100% Tempranillo and aged in American and French oak barrels for 12 months. Ripe tannins make this an excellent food wine- another winner from the young wine makers!

Cabernet Sauvignon, Cousiño-Macul, 'Finis Terrae', Valle de Maipo 2017, Chile 69.95

Powerful blackcurrant fruit on the nose with a hint of strawberry. On the palate the fruit is ripe and rich with noticeable tannin. Aged in oak barrels for 18 months, giving it a rich and complex flavour profile that is characterized by notes of blackberry, vanilla, and blueberry.

Les Calèches de Lanessan, Haut-Médoc 2015, Bordeuax, France 49.95

Attractive fruit nose with cassis and some wonderfully silky tannins and a fresh attractive finish, a perfect accompaniment to a Sunday roast! Plenty of can sauv, with drops of Merlot and Petit Verdot.

Château Montaiguillon, Montagne Saint-Emilion, 2018, France 49.95

Delicious supple red fruit character of plums, blackcurrants and cherries backed up by a good structure and ripe tannins. The property is wonderfully situated looking down to Saint-Emilion and Pomerol.

Chateau Barrail du Blanc Grand Cru St-Emilion 2022, France 65.00

Opaque ruby colour to a delectably dark, juicy, almost inky profound nose. The dark fruit is translated on the palate into a rich, fresh burst of flavours, sweetly structured, nicely balanced and with really good length. One of the best Barrail du Blancs.

Qunita de la Rosa Tinto, Douro, Portugal 39.95

Matured for 12 months in old French oak casks. A medium bodied red with woodland fruits, plum and light herbaceous notes on the nose, whilst the palate is smooth and vibrant. Brilliant with red meat, a great wine from the Douro.

Bouchard Finlayson 'Galpin Peak' Pinot Noir, Walker Bay 2021, South Africa 74.95

Enticing on the nose, very correct, sweet cherry fruit. A beautiful light colour typical of the grape. Super wine and the flagship of the estate. One of France's very best teaming up to bring a proper Burgundy style Pinot Noir.

Rosé wine

Pinot Grigio Blush, Sentito, Italy 6.75 / 25.95

Pinot Grigio pink at its finest. Fresh flavours of raspberry and red cherry with a lifting finish.

Zinfandel Rosé, Wicked Lady, California, USA 6.50 / 24.95

Medium-sweet rosé made using Zinfandel grapes from warm Californian vineyards. Shows red fruits on the rich, juicy palate.

Quinta Do Frances Rosé, Algarve, Portugal 33.95/8.50

Strawberry and aromatic herbs aromas. In the mouth, notes of raspberry, orange and mint. Full-bodied and enveloping wine. Not just a summer wine, this will transport you straight to the sunny days of summer.

Provence Rosé, Domaine Pey Blanc No.1, France 9.00 / 35.95

The rosé of the best holidays! Elegance, freshness, and finesse. Bright, pale colour, aromas of exotic fruits, citrus fruits, white flowers.
