Macon-Verze, Domaine Leflaive 2023, France

110.00

This small offering comes from five, minute, biodynamically farmed plots. It is a joy in 2023. Elegant, biscuity, half-rich nose, a sense of tension and restraint to the pretty perfume. The palate is ripely flavoured, supple and generous but with an impressive 'dry extract' structure underneath. Impressive length as well.

Grape: Chardonnay.

Lugana Riserva DOC 'Sergio Zenato', 2021, Italy

Brilliant gold in colour, Sergio Zenato Riserva Lugana offers an intense yet elegant floral bouquet. Beautifully layered on the palate, this wine tantalises the senses with notes of stone fruit, vanilla and white flowers.

Grape: Trebbiano di Lugana.

Vermentino 'Capichera', Isola dei Nuraghi IGT, Sardinia, 2021, Italy

Straw yellow colour with greenish hues. Generous aromas of tropical fruits, pineapple, apple and aromatic herbs. Dry, savoury and fragrant palate, with citrus and mineral hints.

Grape: Vermentino.

Bourgogne Chardonnay, 'La Tufera', Etienne Sauzet, 2023 85.00
France

Pale in colour with green highlights but plenty of bright, ripe, pear fruit on the nose and palate. It is vibrantly juicy with a lovely ripe citrus character, decent weight, and a wonderful saline character on the finish, making it too easy to drink!

Grape: Chardonnay

Bouchard Père & Fils Chassagne Montrachet, 2020, 160.00
France

Intense floral and stone fruit on the nose. Full-bodied, rich and smooth with a long, lingering finish. Founded in 1731 in Beaune by Michel Bouchard, Bouchard Père & Fils, is one of the oldest wine estates in Burgundy.

Grape: Chardonnay.

Sauvignon Blanc, Cakebread Cellars, 2022, California 90.00

Cakebread Cellars makes high-quality wines from vineyards all over the Napa Valley. They blend a tiny amount of Semillon to their Sauvignon Blanc, for complexity and spice. Round and fleshy for its type, this wine shows notes of citrus, stone fruit and gooseberries.

Grape: Sauvignon Blanc.

El Cerro Chardonnay, Buscado Vivo O Muerto, 2020, Argentina

85.00

Planted at 1,300m in chalk and limestone soils, this Chardonnay boasts a seductive nose, redolent of white blossom, fresh herbs and Braeburn apples. A fine, driven wine with crisp acidity and a long mineral finish. Only 1,800 bottles were made.

Châteauneuf-du-Pape Blanc, Domaine du Vieux Télégraphe, Famille Brunier 2023, France

165.00

A rich, expressive Rhône white wine with layers of lemon curd, ripe pear and dried apricot, lifted by notes of beeswax, crushed hazelnut and stony minerality. Full bodied, yet beautifully balanced, with a long textured finish and remarkable depth. Grapes: Clairette, Grenache, Roussanne and Bourboulanc.

Sauvignon Blanc, Alto Adige DOC, Sanct Valentin St Michael- Eppan, 2023, Italy

80.00

A vibrant alpine Sauvignon Blanc from Alto Adige, showing intense aromas of grapefruit, elderflower, fresh-cut herbs, and white peach. Crisp and mineral-driven on the palate with lively acidity, layered citrus and tropical fruit notes, and a long, elegant finish marked by mountain freshness and precision. Grape: Sauvignon Blanc

Château Musar, Bekaa Valley, Gaston Hochar, 2018, Lebanon

95.00

Full of ripe fruit, cherries, blackcurrants and cranberries with liquorice notes. More earthy, brambly fruit on the palate with blackberries, blueberries and cherries amongst the spice.

Grape: Cabernet Sauvignon blend.

Amarone Classico Della Valpolicella Riserva, 'Sergio Zenato', 2018, Italy

The crown in the Zenato range, this award-winning Amarone Riserva from the highly prized Zenato Estate is a fantastic example of the true potential of Amarone. Deep ruby red in colour. Extremely intense on the nose with a spicy, dried-fruit bouquet. Full, flavoursome and well-structured on the palate with strong yet supple tannins and amazing length. A truly magnificent wine.

Grapes: Corvina, Oseleta, Rondinella.

Pomerol, Clos du Clocher, 2017, France

Superb floral nose that gives way to rich black fruit on the palate. Plenty of tannin, generous and long flavour underpinned by layers of creamy oak. Very good.

Grape: Merlot with some Cabernet Franc.

Tenuta Tignanello Marchese Antinori, Chianti Classico Riserva, 2022, Italy

225.00

Plenty of vibrant red fruit on the nose and palate with a gentle floral note. Sweet fruited on the palate with hints of warm spices before a silky mouth-feel and a clean, fresh finish.

Grape: Sangiovese/Brunello.

PSI Bodegas Y Vinedos Alnardo, 2022, Spain

110.00

PSI comes from a patchwork of small old-vine parcels throughout Ribera del Duero, which are over 50 years old on average, although some are over a century old. The 2022 is a serious PSI – sinewy and red-berried, moreishly drinkable, with crunchy definition.

Grape: Tempranillo.

Othello Dominus Estate, 2016, Napa Valley, California, USA

Christian Moueix fell in love with the Napa Valley and its wines. In 1981, he discovered the historic Napanook Vineyard, a 42-hectare site which provided fruit for some of the finest Napa wines of the 1940s and 1950s. The name Dominus, ‘Master’ in Latin, may have been ambitious but turned out to be wholly justified!

Grape: Cabernet Sauvignon blend.

Brunello di Montalcino, Sesti, Castello di Argiano, 2020, Italy 160.00

A fantastic, complex wine with blackberries, loganberries, herbs and spices on the nose, the palate is even richer with fine tannins and a savoury note of black truffle.

Grape: Sangiovese.

Barolo DOCG 'Enrico VI' Cordero di Montezemolo, 2019, Italy 240.00

An elegant and powerful Barolo from the renowned Enrico VI vineyard in La Morra. Aromas of black cherry, dried rose, eucalyptus and sweet spice lead into a structured palate layered with dark berries, licorice and fine, polished tannins. Complex and beautifully balanced with a long, savoury finish.

Grape: Nebbiolo.

Rioja Gran Reserva, Belezos, Bodegas Zugober, 2014, Spain 95.00

A traditionally styled Rioja Gran Reserva with extended oak and bottle aging, offering layered aromas of black cherry, dried fig, cedar, tobacco, and sweet spice. Silky and refined on the palate with notes of dark fruit, leather, vanilla, and earthy complexity balanced by polished tannins and fresh acidity. Elegant, persistent finish.

Grape: Tempranillo.
